Most of the rocks under the soil in Andhra Pradesh consists of granites which are hard and impervious. However the top portion of these rocks (about 20 metres) are broken and they carry water. Many of these rocks also have deep cracks going down to 50 or 100 metres depth. These crack's too contain water. Normally, with ordinary wells

that we dig, we tap the water present in the top weathered layer. Tube wells, which are dug with the help of drill mechines, reach the deep cracks and draw water from them.


