Agriculture and Irrigation

Many of the achievements of the Cholas were made possible through new developments in agriculture. Notice the river Kaveri branches off into several small streams before emptying in to the Bay of Bengal. These streams overflow frequently, depositing fertile soil on their banks. Water from the streams also provides the necessary moisture for agriculture, particularly the cultivation of rice.

Although agriculture had developed in Tamilnadu, it was only from the fifth or sixth century that this area was opened up large scale cultivation. Forestes had to be cleared in some regions, land had to be leveled in other areas. In the delta region embankments had to be built to prevent flooding and canals had to be constructed to carry water, to the fields. In many areas two crops were grown in a year.

Most of the rocks under the soil in Andhra Pradesh consists of granites which are hard and impervious. However the top portion of these rocks (about 20 metres) are broken and they carry water. Many of these rocks also have deep cracks going down to 50 or 100 metres depth. These crack's too contain water. Normally, with ordinary wells

that we dig, we tap the water present in the top weathered layer. Tube wells, which are dug with the help of drill machines, reach the deep cracks and draw water from them.

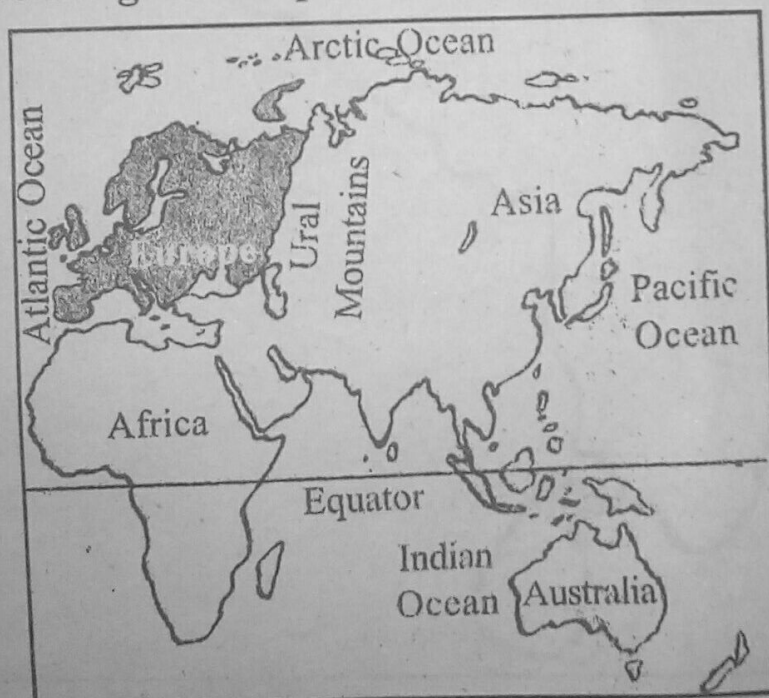

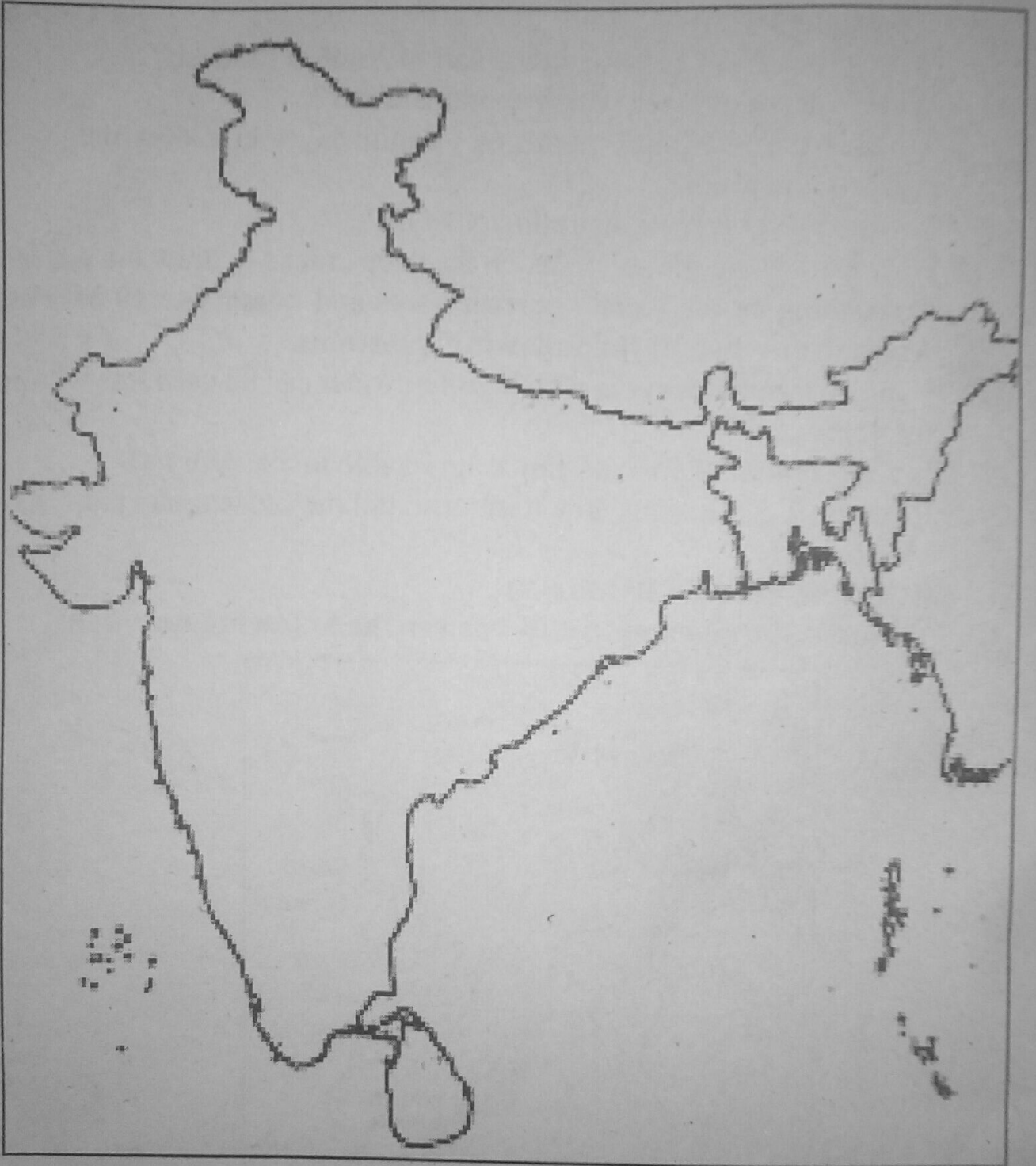
